In February 2003, the European Union issued Directive 2002/95/EC on the restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS).

This RoHS directive requires producers of electrical and electronic equipment to restrict the use of 6 environmentally-sensitive substances : lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium and the use of PBB and PBDE flame retardants, in electrical and electronic products, sold in the European Union beginning July 1st, 2006.

NCE has established a process for maintaining the integrity of RoHS compliant units received for repair, See diagram below.
